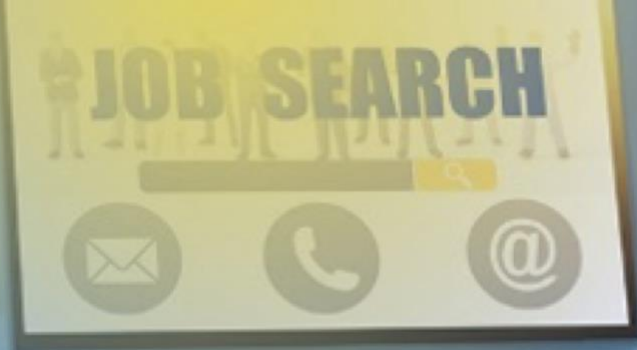

Two years (full-time) postdoctoral experience and specialized training in the study and practice of clinical neuropsychology and related neurosciences supervised by a board-certified clinical neuropsychologist. Experience in presurgical epilepsy evaluations, including Wada testing. Necessary skills required to conduct neuropsychological evaluations and interventions with patients and their families, and as a member of a diverse health care team.

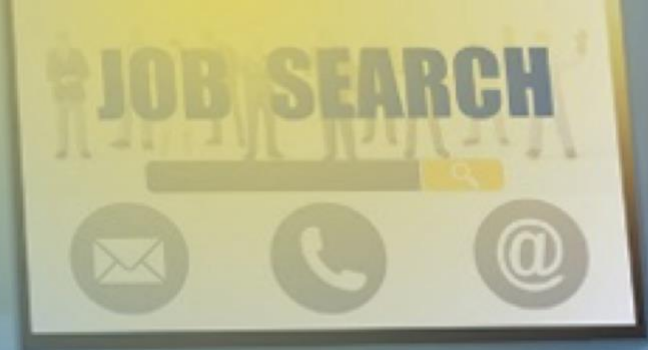

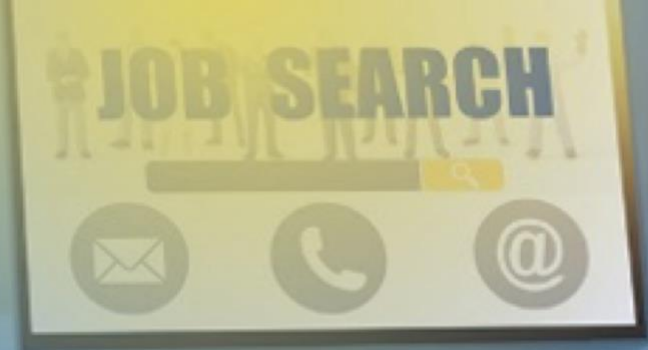
