# Admissions Requirements

## Bachelor's Degree Programs

- Completion of a minimum of 84 quarter or 56 semester units of transfer credit
- Completion of general education requirements
- One introductory-level psychology course (i.e. General Psychology) and a mathematics requirement of Intermediate Algebra or higher
- Online application

## Master's Degree Programs

- Must hold a bachelor's degree from a regionally-accredited institution or the international equivalent
- Online application through PSYCAS (Application fee)
- Resume or CV
- Statement of purpose
- Letters of recommendation from three academic or professional references
- Official transcripts
- MS in Psychology applicants must complete these prerequisite courses:
  - › Developmental Psychology
  - › Physiological or Biological Psychology
  - › Personality or Abnormal Psychology
  - › Statistics

International applicants for all programs may have additional requirements.

## Clinical Psychology Doctoral Programs

- Must hold a bachelor's degree from a regionally-accredited institution or the international equivalent
- Online application through PSYCAS (Application fee)
- Resume or CV
- Statement of purpose
- Official transcripts
- Letters of recommendation from three academic or professional references
- PhD in Clinical Psychology prerequisite classes:
  - › Developmental Psychology
  - › Physiological or Biological Psychology
  - › Personality or Abnormal Psychology
  - › Statistics

## PhD in Counselor Education and Supervision

- Students must reside in California within sufficient proximity to the University
- Must hold a master's degree in counseling
- Must have successfully completed masters-level core curriculum aligned with CACREP curriculum standards as well as content in at least one CACREP-aligned specialty area.
