Prior to Palo Alto University, Dr. Dey served as the founding Vice Provost for Integrative Learning and Life Design at <u>Johns Hopkins University</u>, where he led a division of 15 departments and centers dedicated to bridging academic and experiential learning with professional development, mentoring, and life design. Under his leadership, the university launched a pioneering vision for equitable career outcomes, expanded alumni and employer engagement, secured funding for immersive student experiences, and established the <u>Imagine Center for Integrative Learning and Life Design</u>. His work transformed the student experience at <u>Johns Hopkins University</u>, achieving record levels of engagement, satisfaction, and career success.

Throughout his career, Dr. Dey has held leadership roles at <u>Stanford University</u> as Dean of Career and Experiential Education and Associate Vice Provost, at <u>Carnegie Mellon University</u> as Director of Career and Professional Development, and has served on the boards of national organizations, including the <u>National Association of Colleges and Employers</u> (NACE) and the <u>American College Personnel Association</u> (ACPA).

Dr. Dey holds a PhD and an EdS in Educational Leadership, an MBA, an MEd in Counseling Psychology, and a BBA in Finance. His career and life design expertise and workforce trends has made him a sought-after speaker, consultant, and thought leader.
